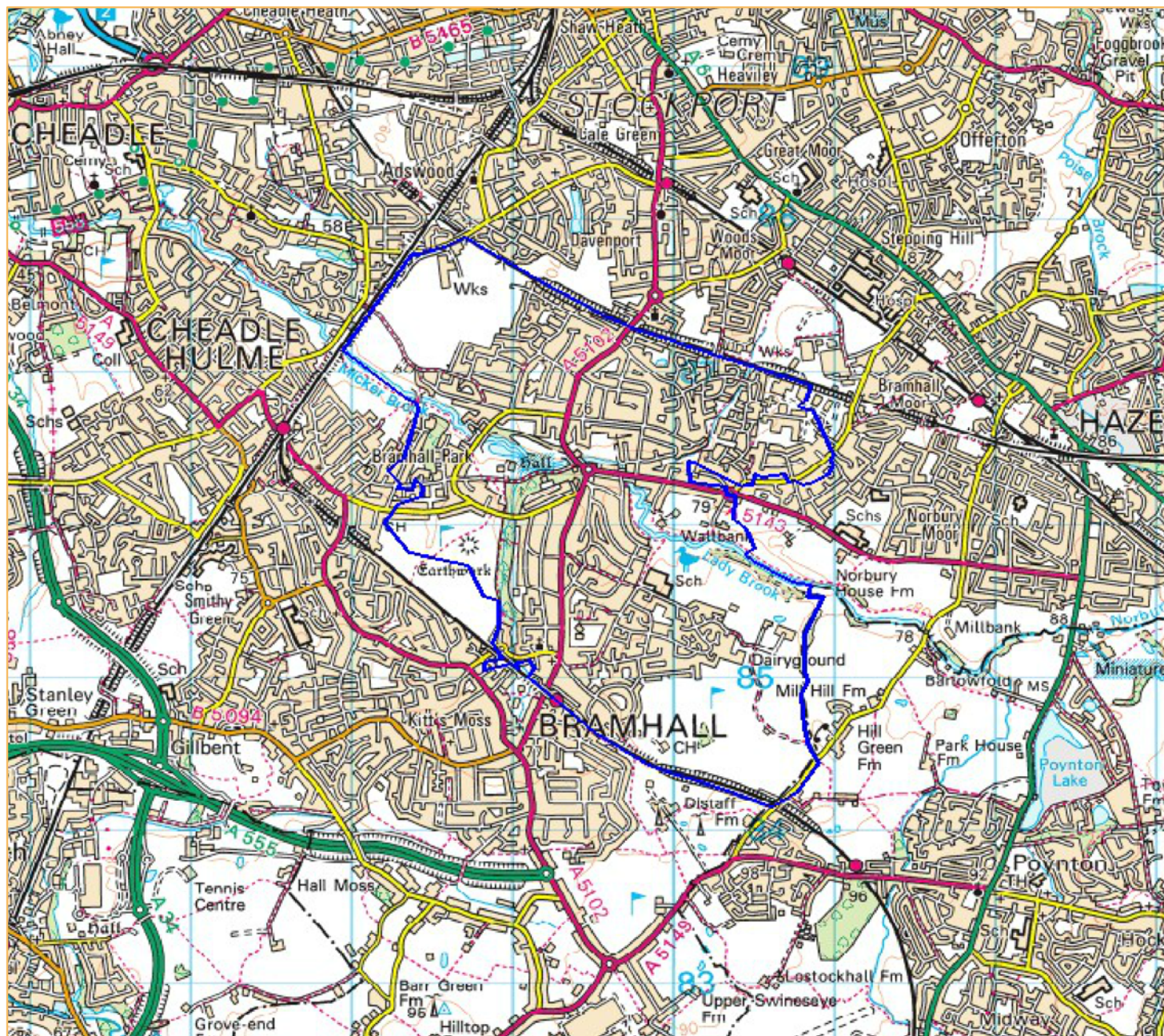

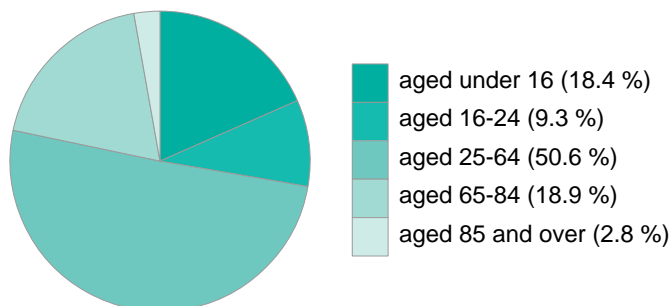

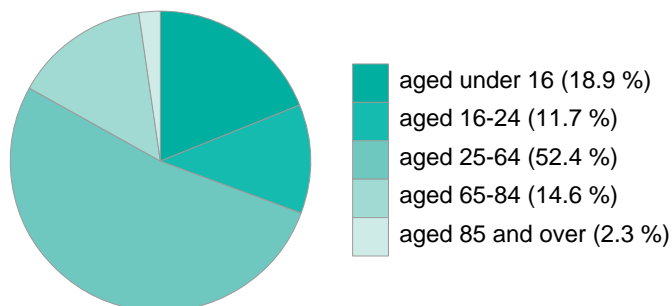

England



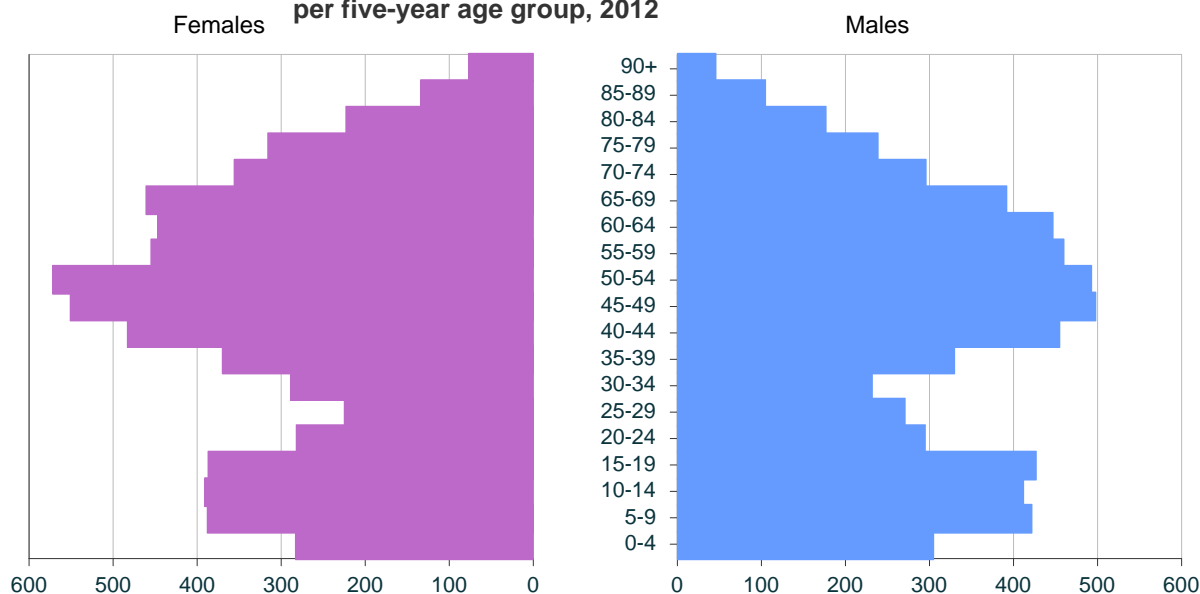

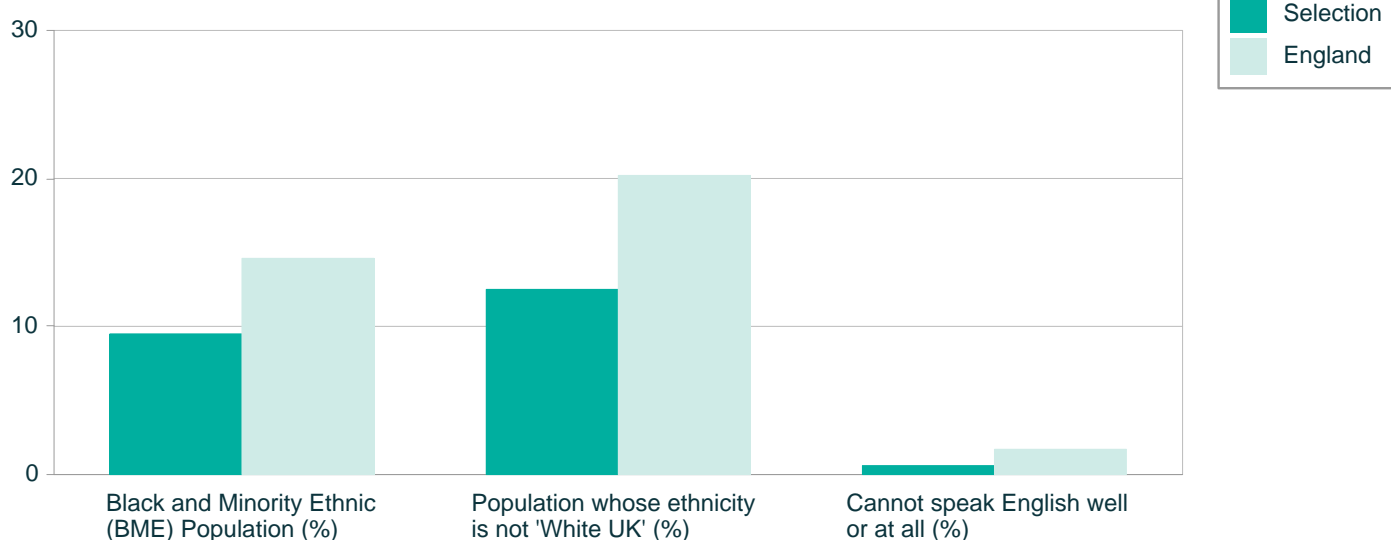

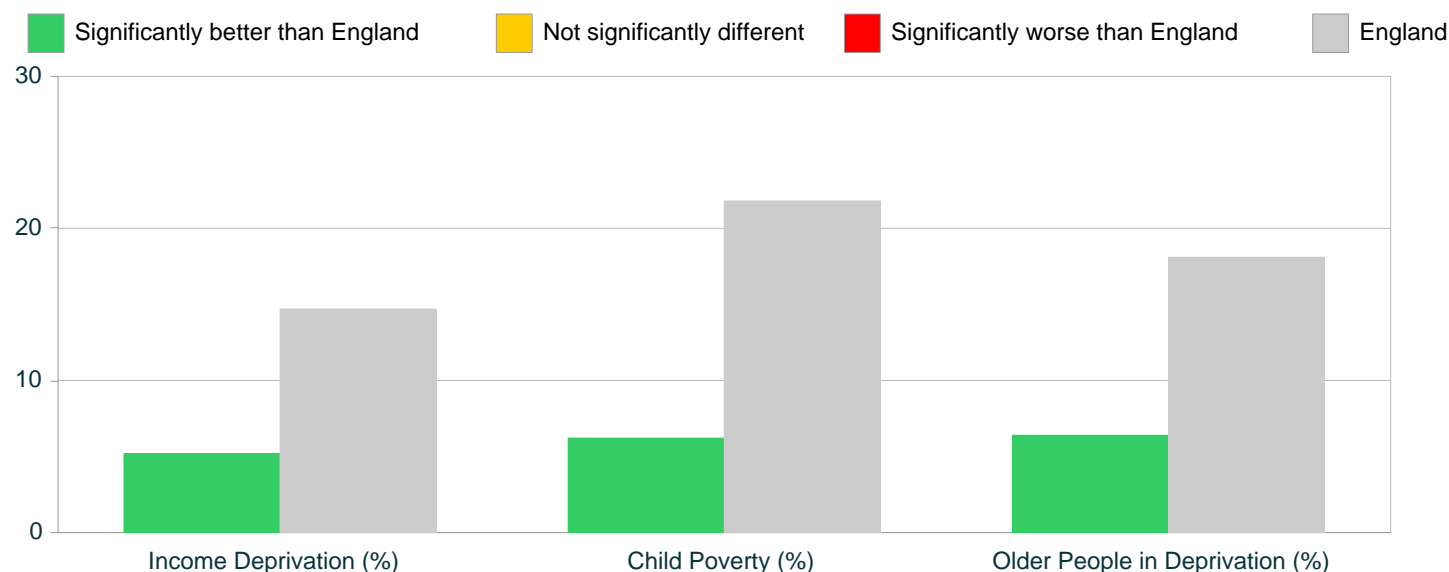

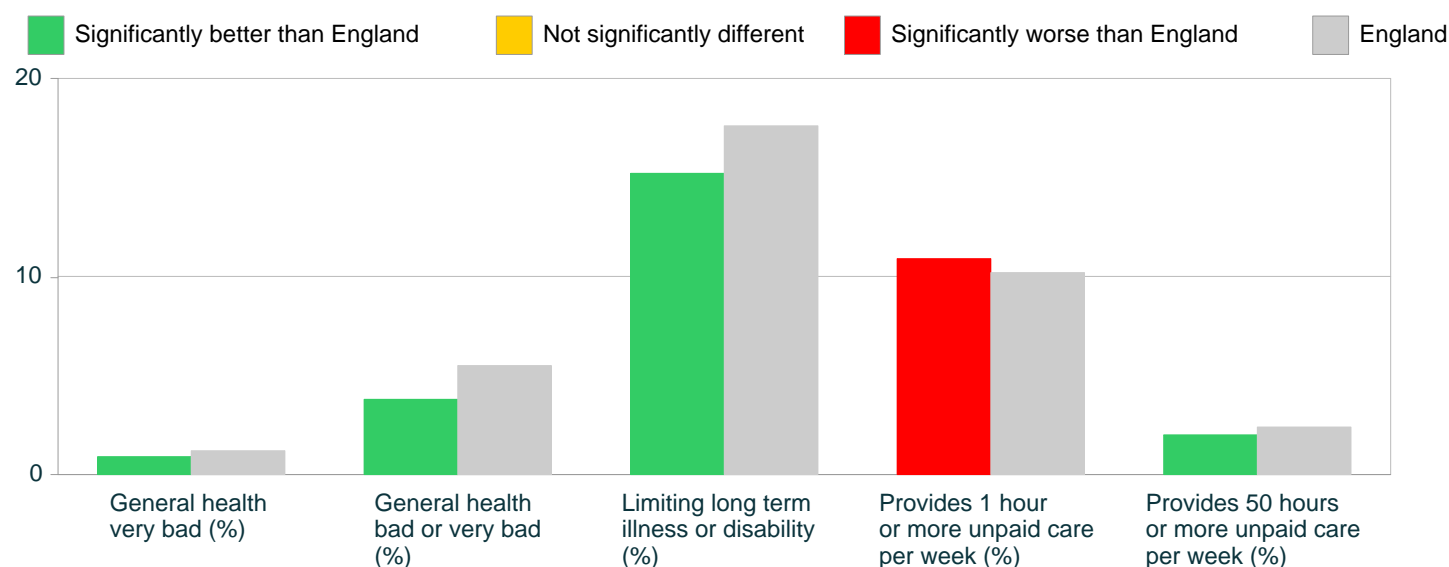

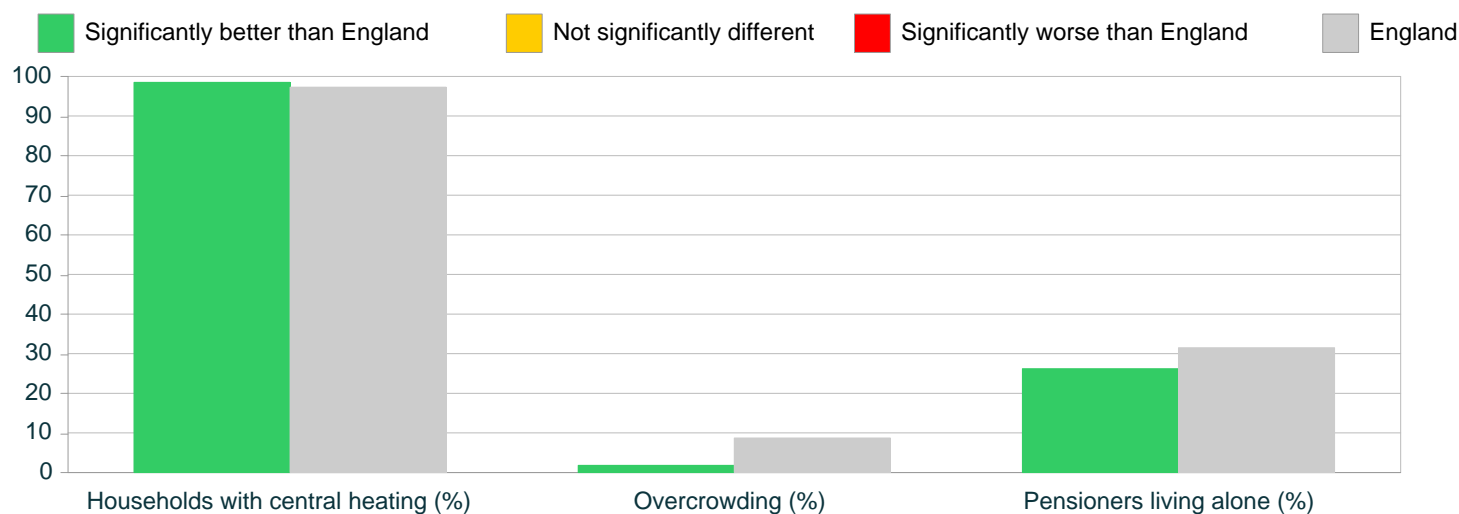

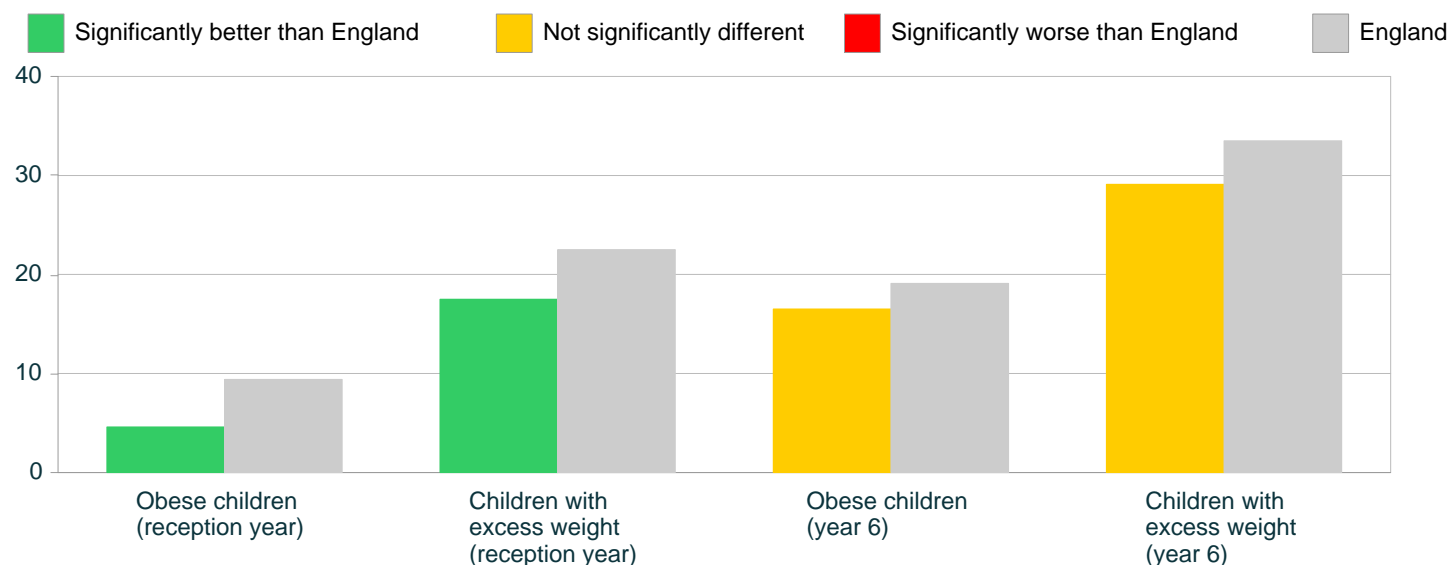

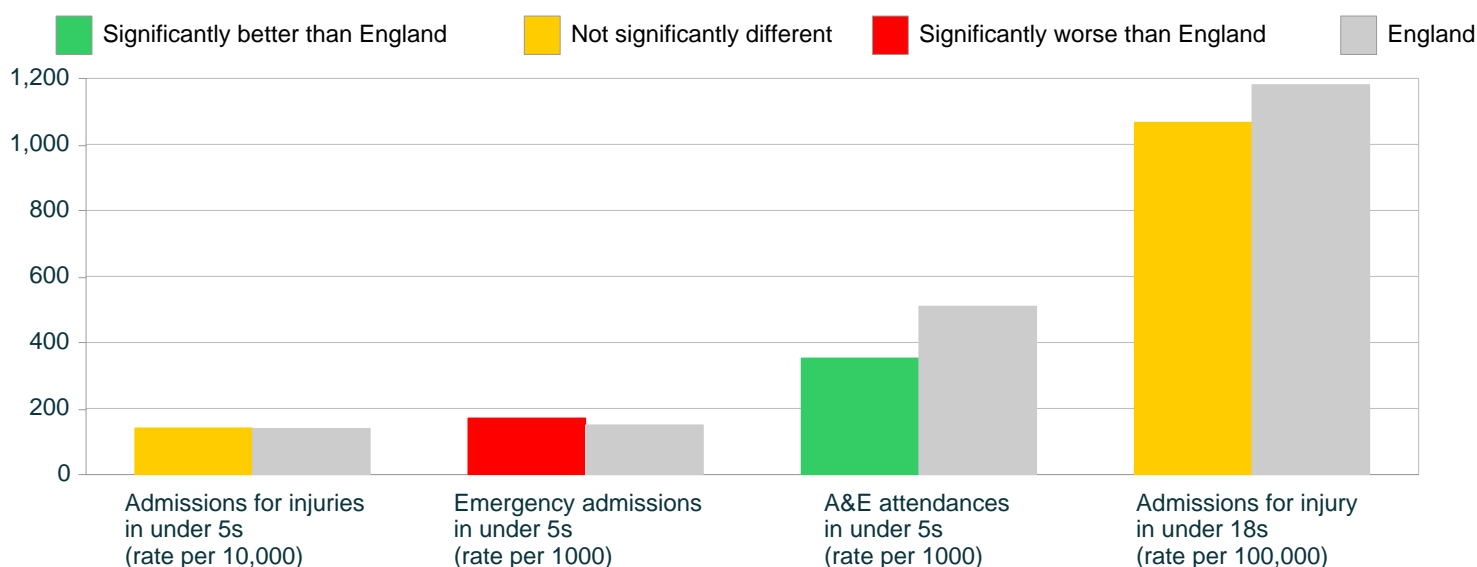

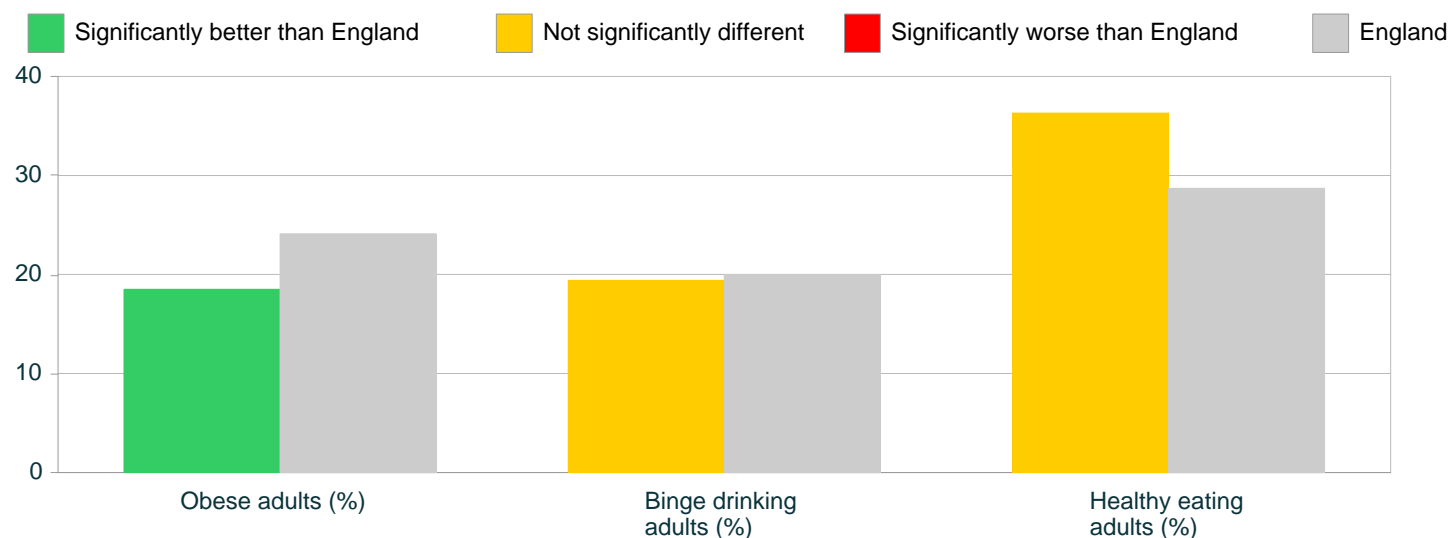

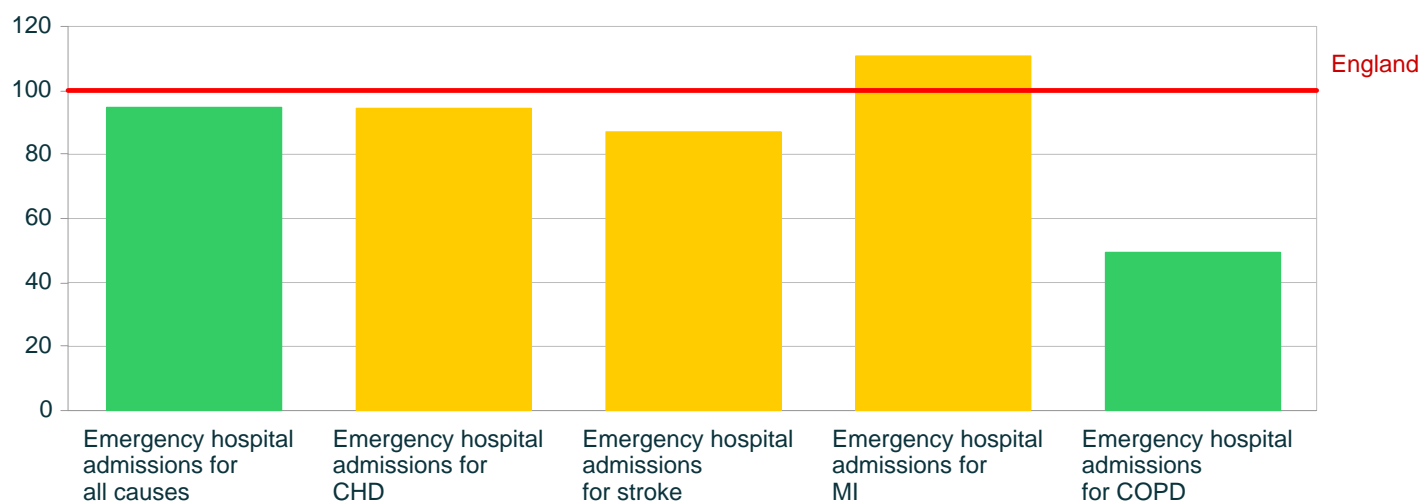

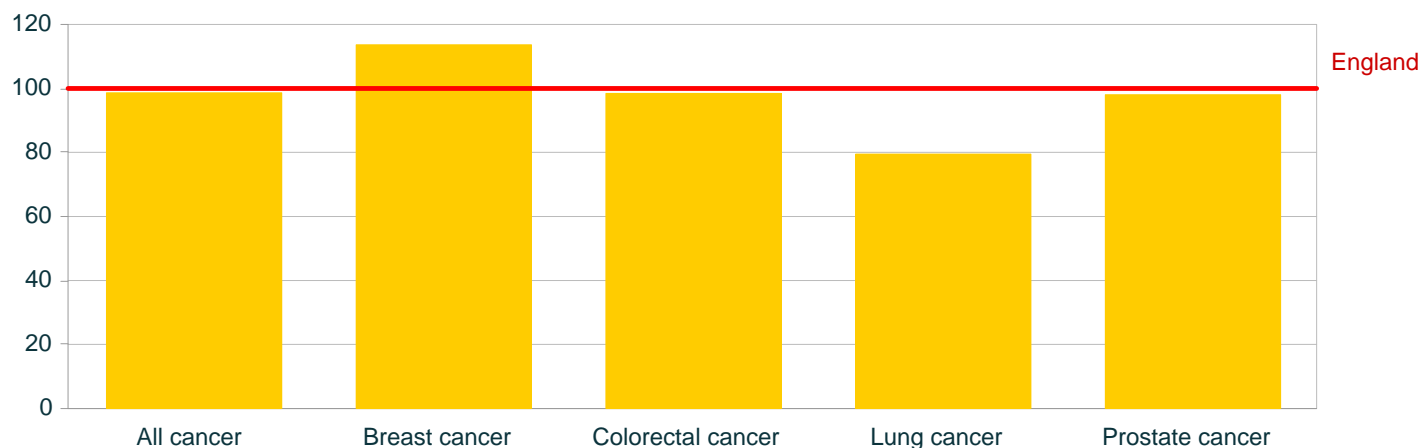

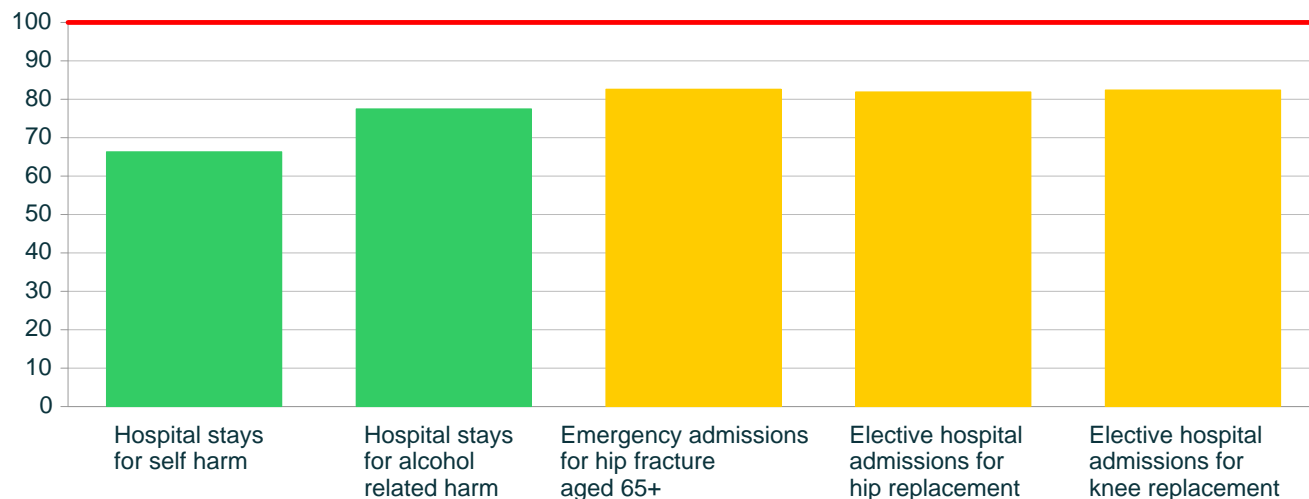

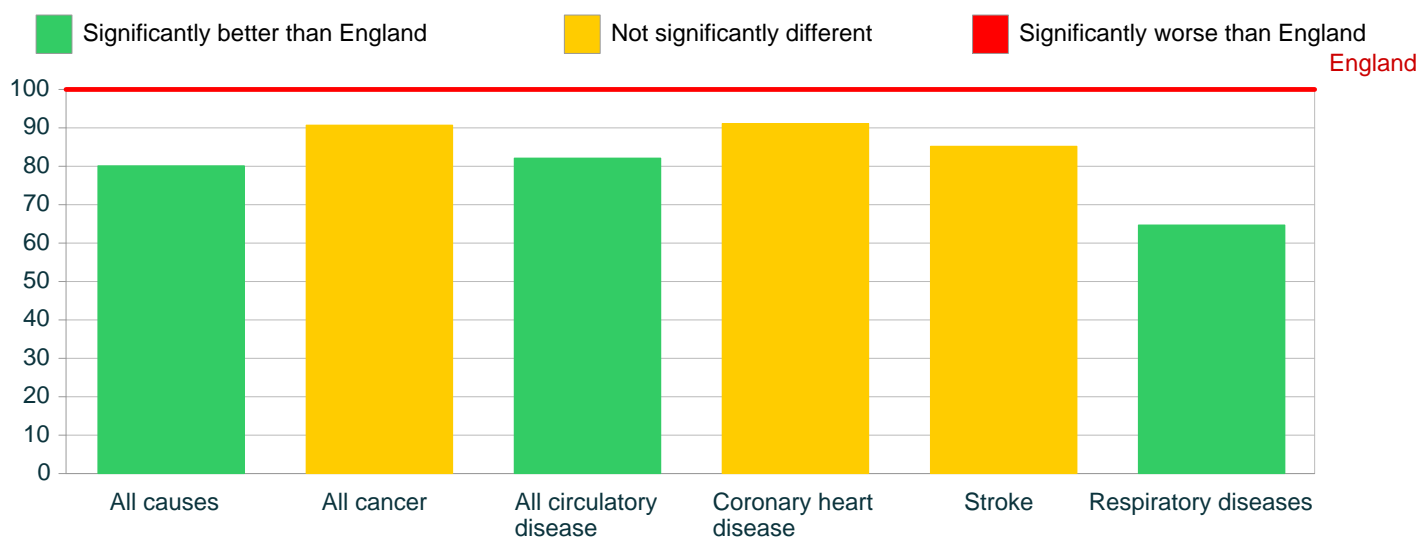

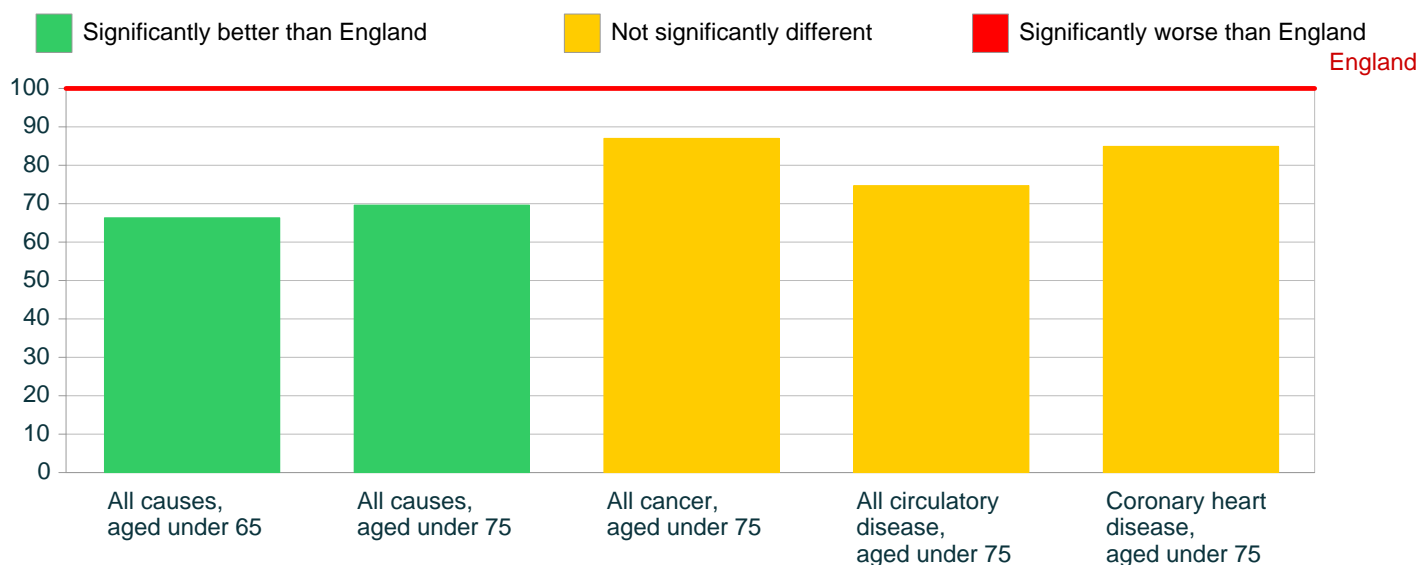

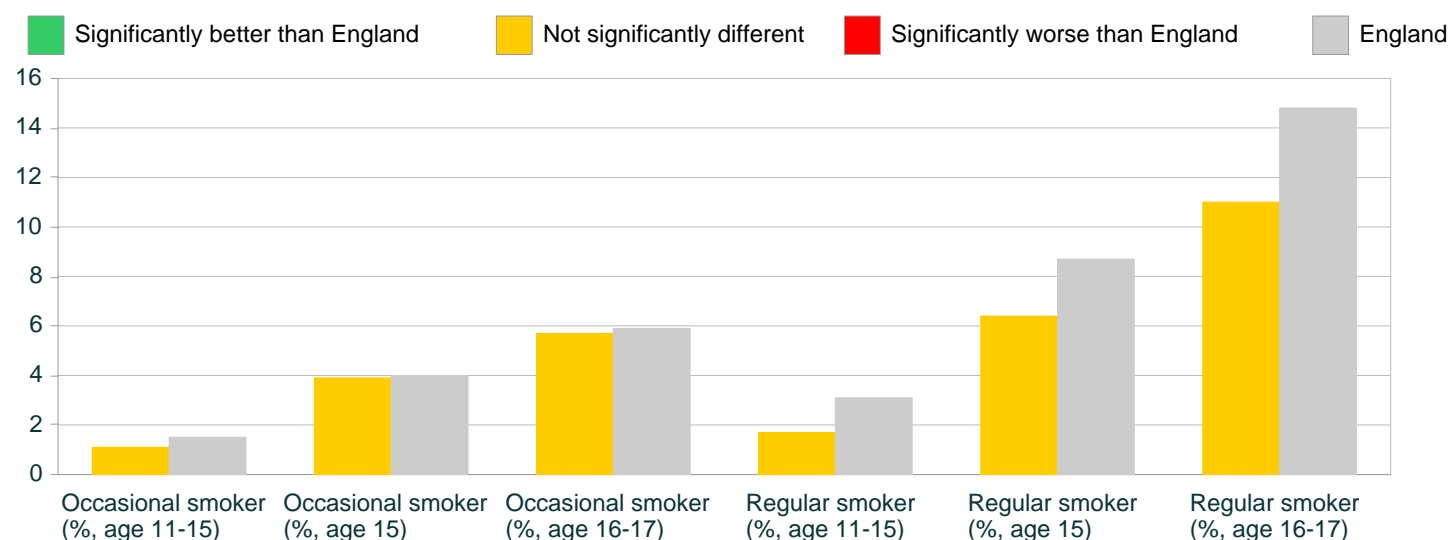

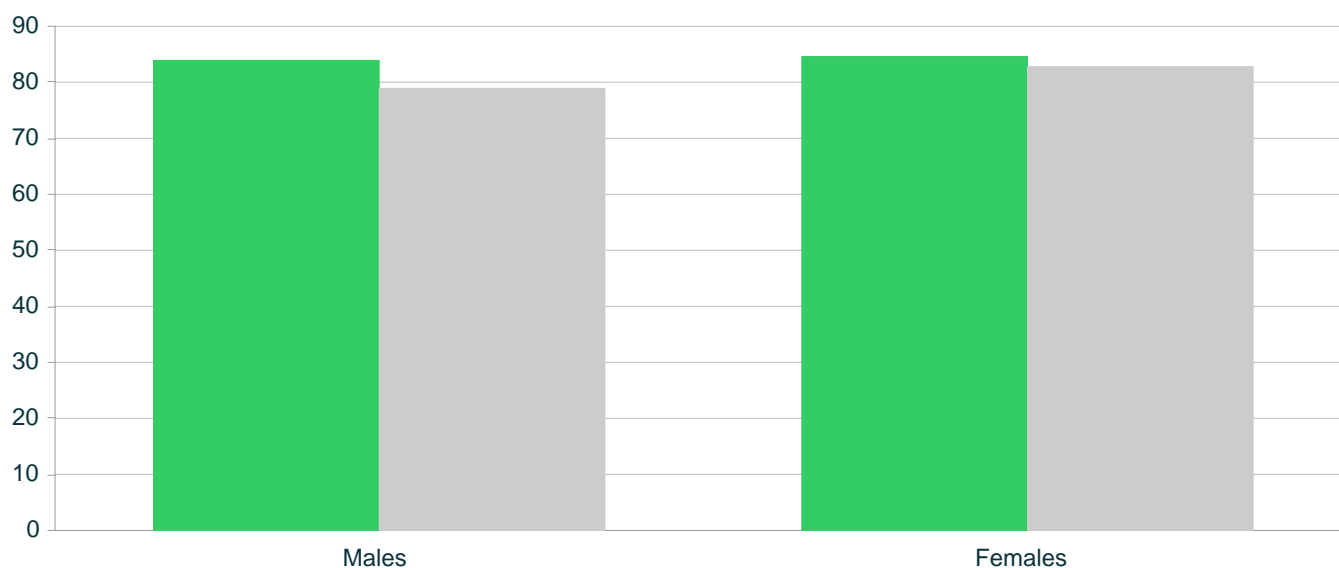
