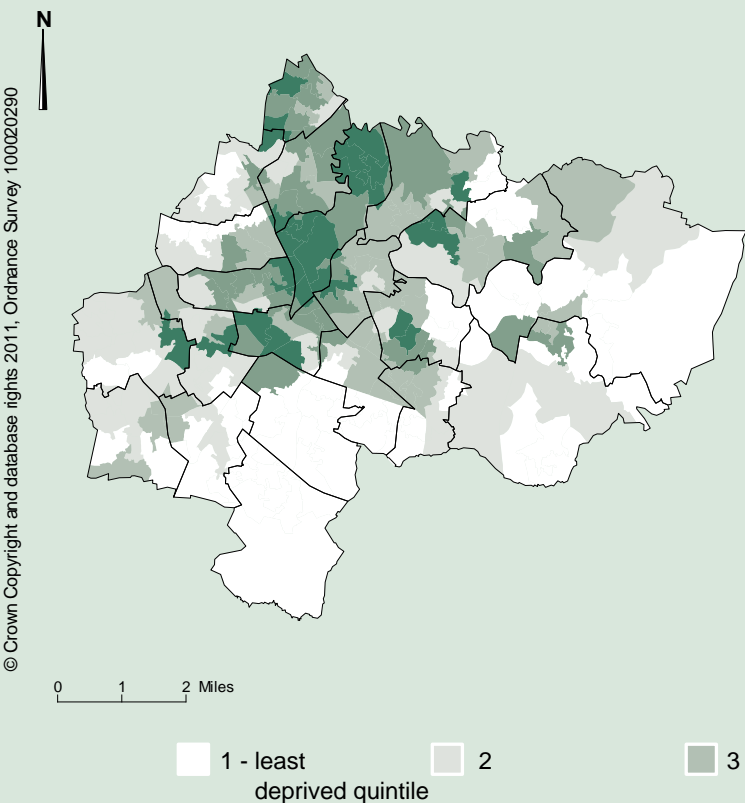
## Stockport at a glance

- The health of people in Stockport is mixed compared to the England average. Deprivation is lower than average, however 9,210 children live in poverty. Life expectancy for both men and women is similar to the England average.
- Life expectancy is 11 years lower for men and 9.2 years lower for women in the most deprived areas of Stockport than in the least deprived areas (based on the Slope Index of Inequality published on 5th January 2011).
- Over the last 10 years, all cause mortality rates have fallen. Early death rates from cancer and from heart disease and stroke have fallen and are similar to the England average.
- About 16.5% of Year 6 children are classified as obese. 55.5% of pupils spend at least three hours each week on school sport. Levels of tooth decay in children are worse than the England average.
- An estimated 17.7% of adults smoke and 22.0% are obese. The rate of hospital stays for alcohol related harm is higher than average.
- Priorities in Stockport include reducing consumption of, and harm related to, alcohol, improving and promoting mental wellbeing and resilience and reducing health inequalities by giving children a healthy start. For more information see [www.nhsstockport.nhs.uk](http://www.nhsstockport.nhs.uk)

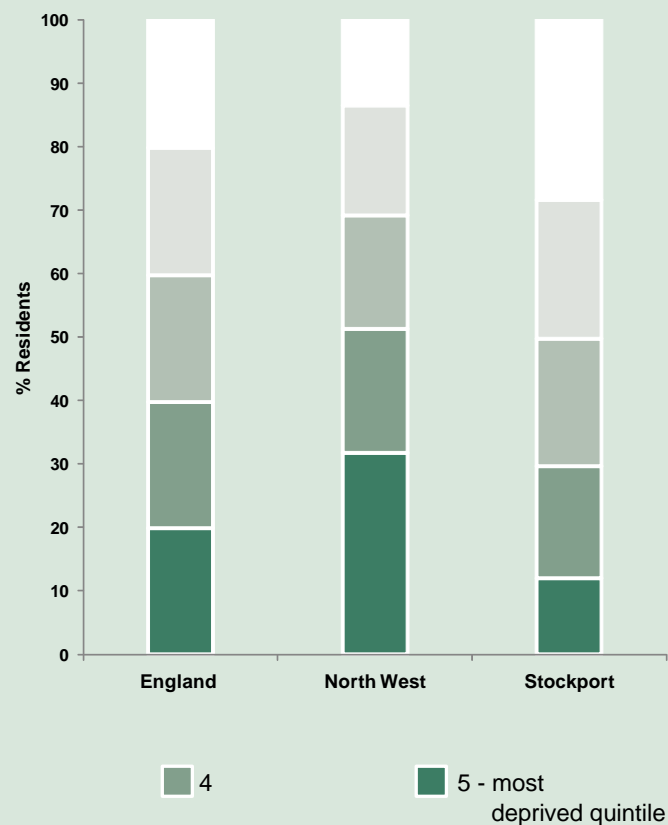


## Deprivation: a national view

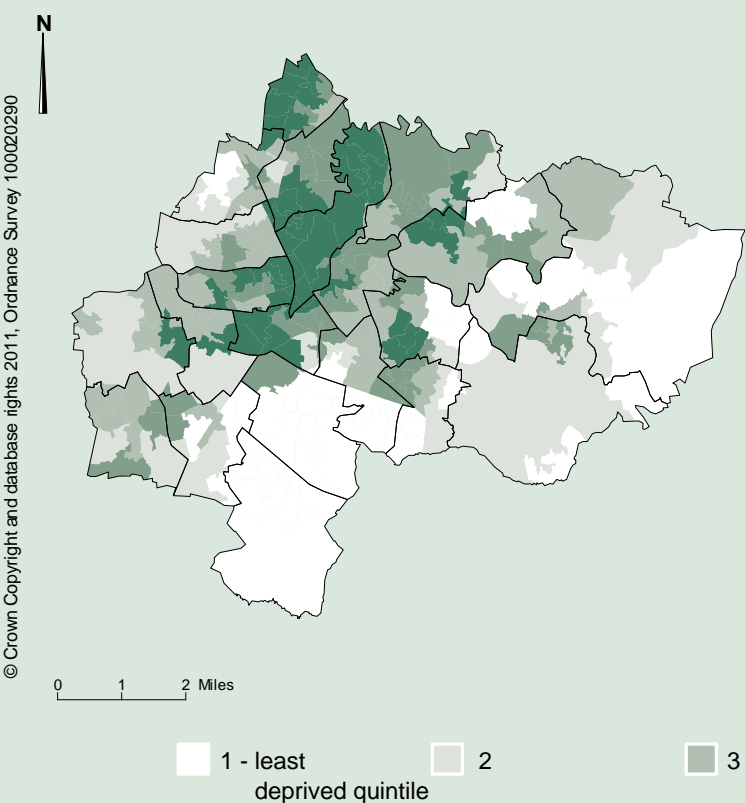


This chart shows the percentage of the population in England, this region, and this area who live in each of these quintiles.

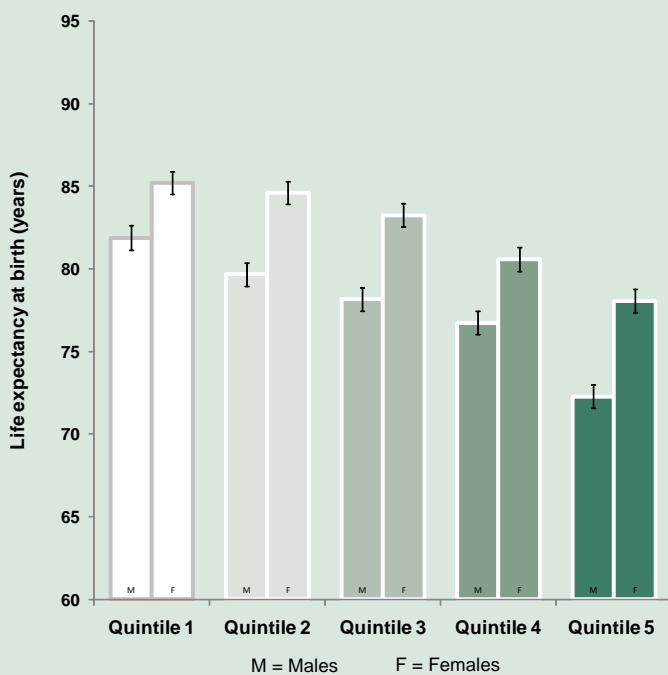


## Health inequalities: a local view

## Health inequalities: changes over time

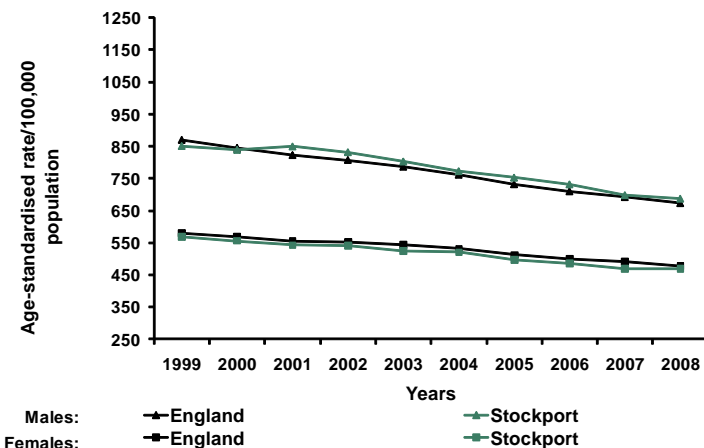

Trend 1 compares rates of death, at all ages and from all causes, in this area with those for England.

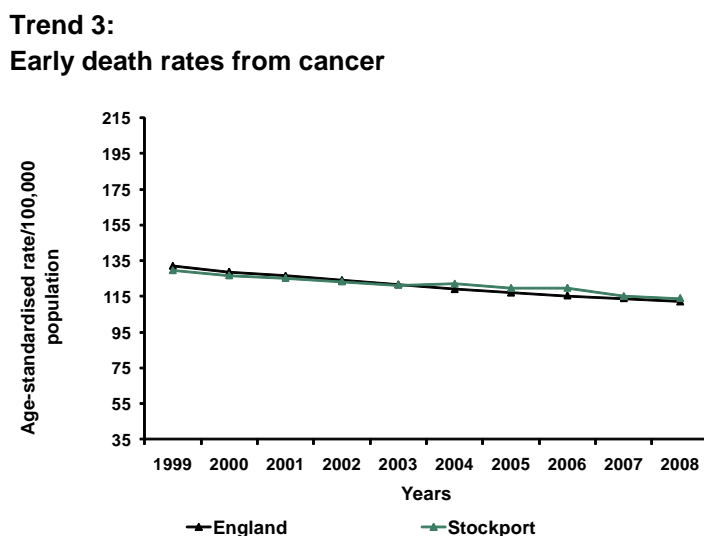
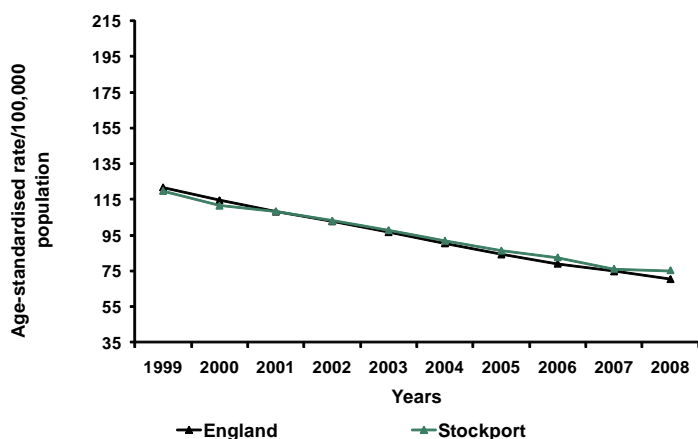
Trend 2 compares rates of early death from heart disease and stroke (in people under 75) in this area with those for England.

### Trend 1: All age, all cause mortality

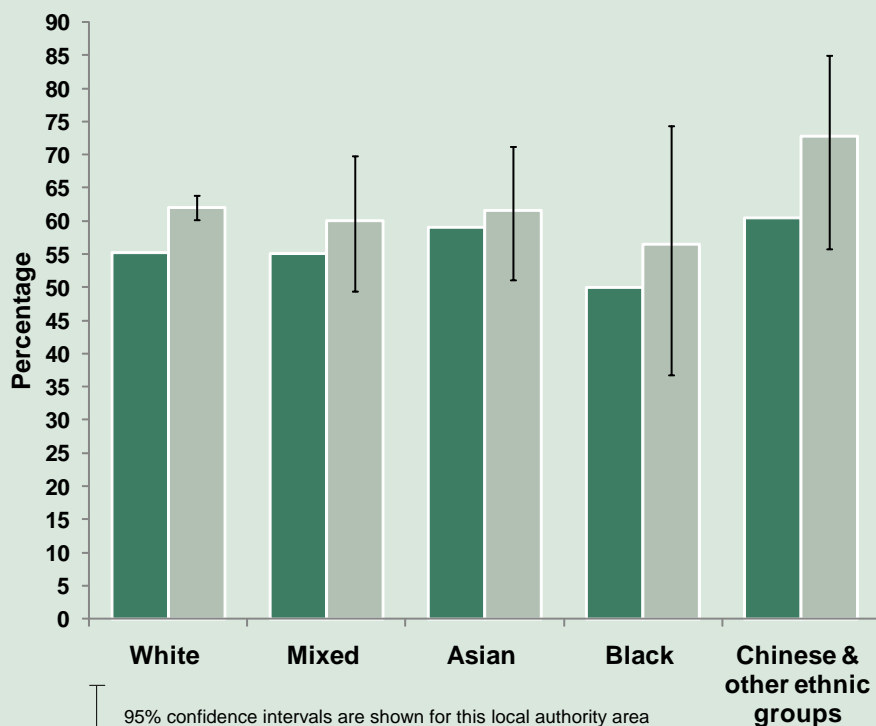


### Trend 2: Early death rates from heart disease and stroke

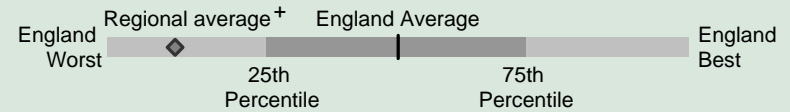

# Health summary for Stockport

The chart below shows how the health of people in this area compares with the rest of England. This area's result for each indicator is shown as a circle. The average rate for England is shown by the black line, which is always at the centre of the chart. The range of results for all local areas in England is shown as a grey bar. A red circle means that this area is significantly worse than England for that indicator; however, a green circle may still indicate an important public health problem.
