CHALLENGES TO STAYING HEALTHY - JSNA FOR BRAMHALL AND CHEADLE

Pregnancy & first year of life (< I)

649 live births in 2006

- Smoking in pregnancy -8.5% of smoke at delivery
- Low birth weight 6.0% less than 2.5kg
- Breastfeeding 56.3% breastfeed at 4 weeks
- **↑** BME 13% of births

Childhood (1 - 15)

■ 13,271 children at 30/06/07 (17.1%)

- Diet and nutrition 22% of those 10-15 years eat '5 a day'
- Physical exercise 54% of those 10-15 years exercise I hour a day
- Child obesity 9.5% for reception & Year 6
- 1 Immunisation 97% primary & 91% MMR
- Accidents 12 deaths 2002-2006 in Stockbort
- Getting the best out of school
 64% 5+ A*-C
- Early smoking 4% of those 10-15 years
- Early drinking— 14% of those 10-15 years drink weekly
- → Disability −305 get disability benefits
- Mental Health 470 get CAMHs in Stockport
- **★** BME 13.7% of primary school pupils
- Child poverty 0% in most deprived areas
- ACS conditions 190 admissions a year (ENT or asthma)

Young adulthood (16 - 24)

1 7,844 people at 30/06/07 (10.1%)

- ★ Binge drinking 61% drink more than twice daily limit on one day
- Drugs 13% take drugs weekly
 Smoking 30% smoke
- Sexual Health -
 - 169% protect against pregnancy
 - 191% protect against STIs
- Teenage conceptions 17.6 per 1,000
- New parents 11% mothers aged <25
- Accidents 11 deaths 2002-2006 in Stockbort
- Suicide 7 deaths 2002-2006 in Stockbort
- Value of work 4% of 16-18's are NEET
- Disability 255 on disability benefits

Healthy adulthood (25 - 64)

1 41,046 people at 30/06/07 (55.1%)

- ↑ New parents − 4.6% new mothers aged 40+
- ∇alue of staying in work –
 1.0% unemployed
- Poverty 2.4% on income related benefits
- Impact of earlier lifestyle choices
 - 12% still smoke
 - 43% binge drink
 - 🚺 10.6% are obese
- 35% have low mental wellbeing
- Long term conditions All Ages:
 - Hypertension 11,141
 - CHD 3,585
 - Diabetes 2,958
 - **T** Asthma 4,891
 - ____COPD 969
 - **CKD 1,557
 - Depression 5,737
- Disability 3,195 on disability benefits
- Access to screening 77% breast, 82% cervical
- Preparing to age well
 23% eat 5 a day
 - 21.2% exercise

Older people (65+)

14,961 people at 30/06/07 (19.2%)

- Healthy life expectancy East Bramhall 5.6 years ill health at end of life, Heald Green 7.4
- ACS conditions 440 admissions a year (chronic conditions)
- Long-term illness 43.3% have a LLTI
- Accidents falls cause 14 deaths & 500 A&E attendances
- Depression 24.1% low mental well-being
- ☐ Dementia 333 people
- Poor diet 22.2% eat '5 a day'
- Weight problems
 - **1** 10.2% obese
 - 36.7% overweight
- Flu vaccination 77.1%
- Independent Living 4,700 live alone
- Access to support 829 receive social service support
- Caring 4.1% do 50+ hours a week
- Older poverty 2% in most deprived areas

TOTAL POPULATION = 77,753 (*GP* Registered at 30/06/07)
