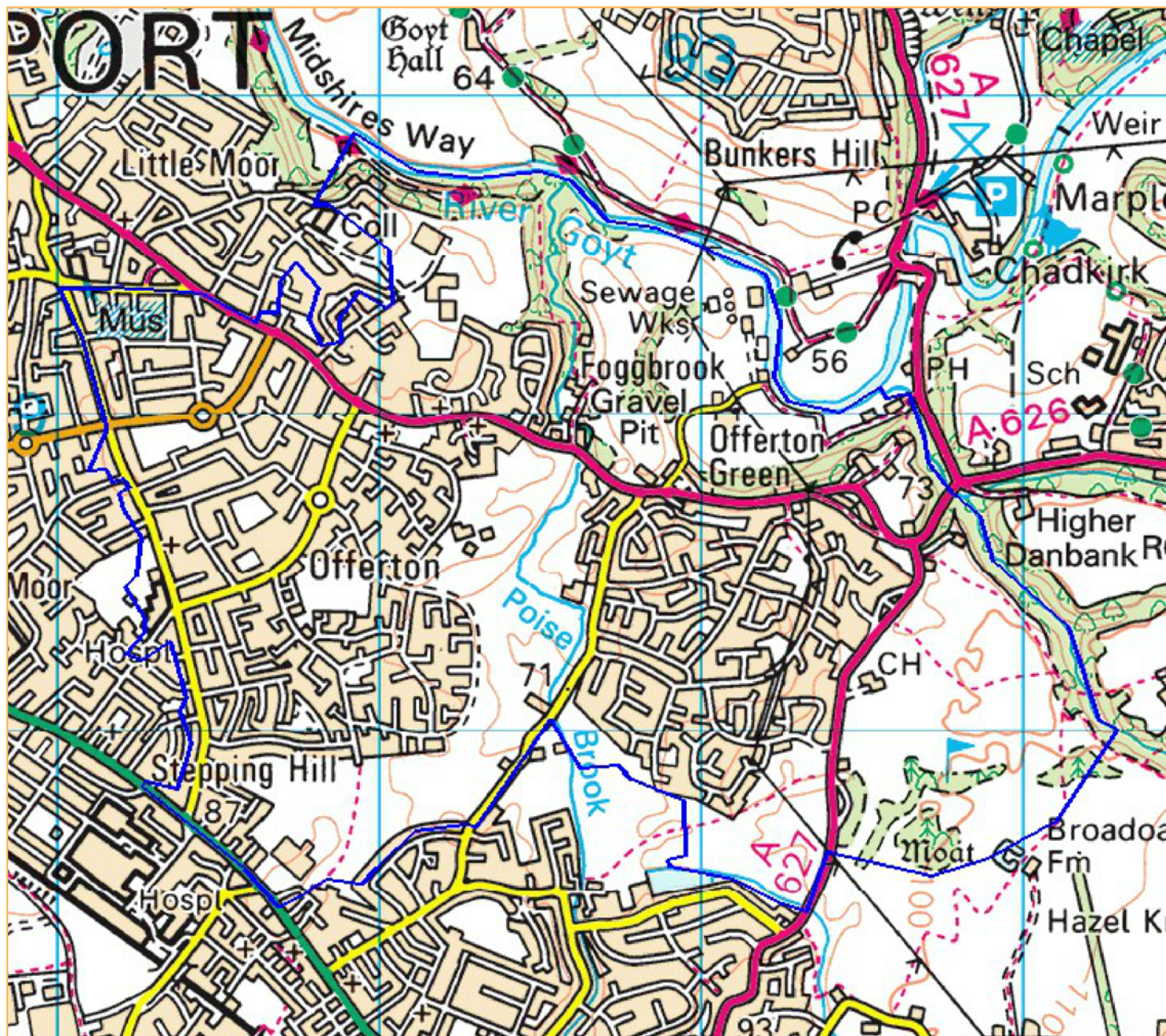

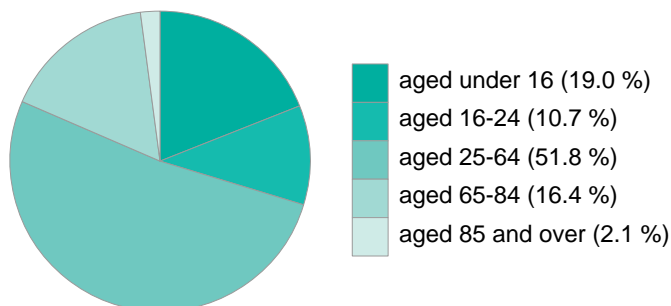

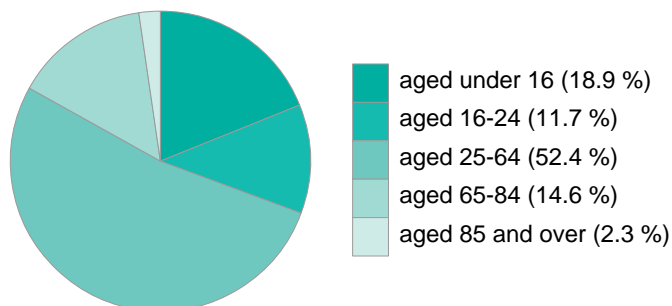

England



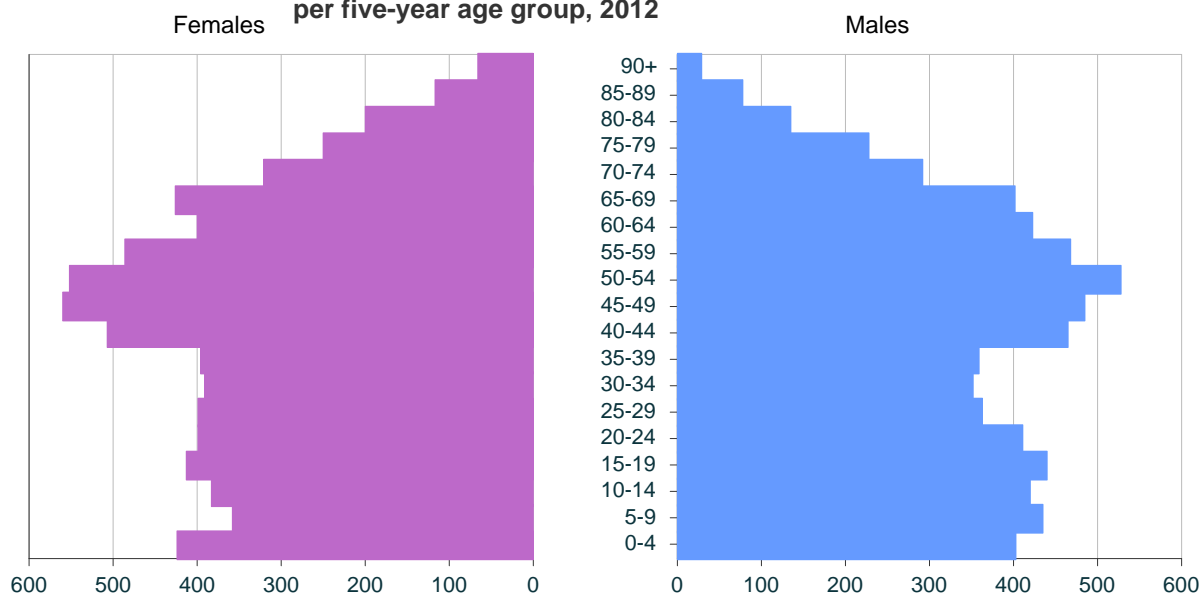

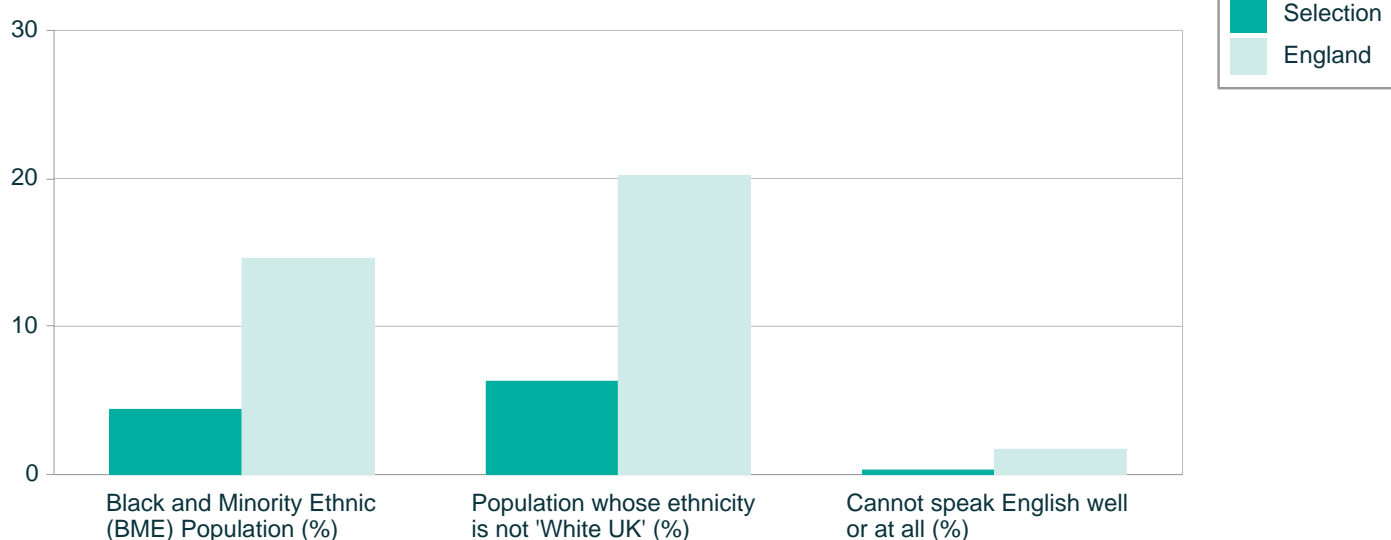

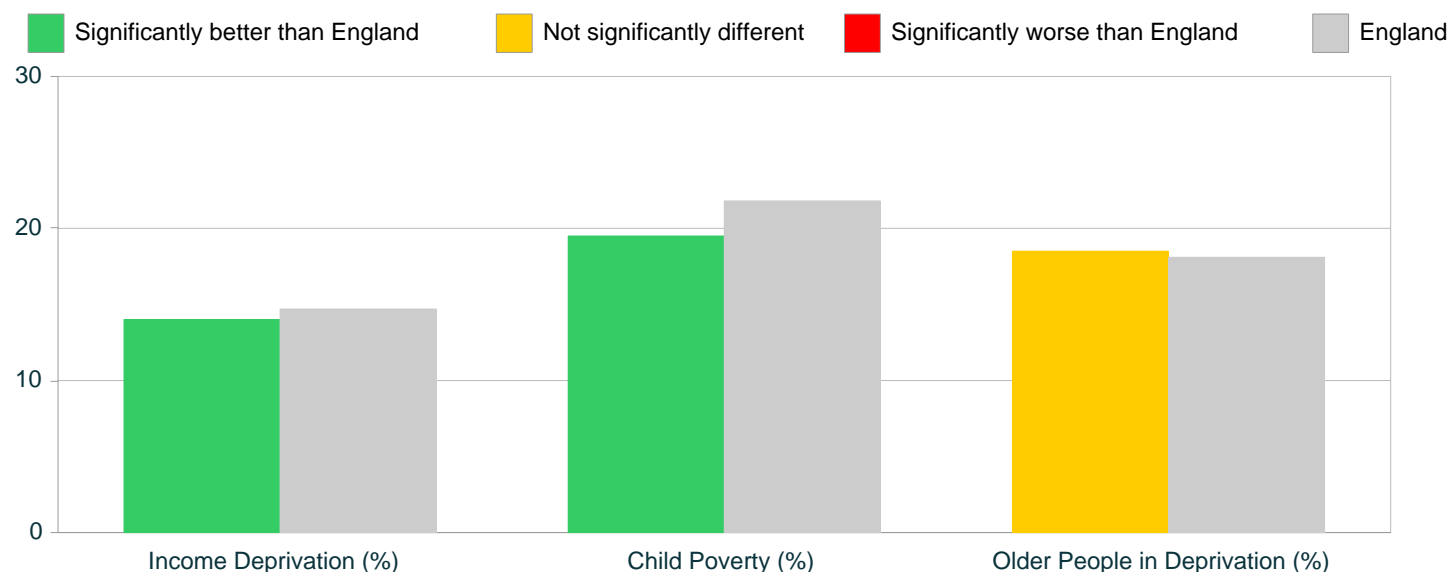

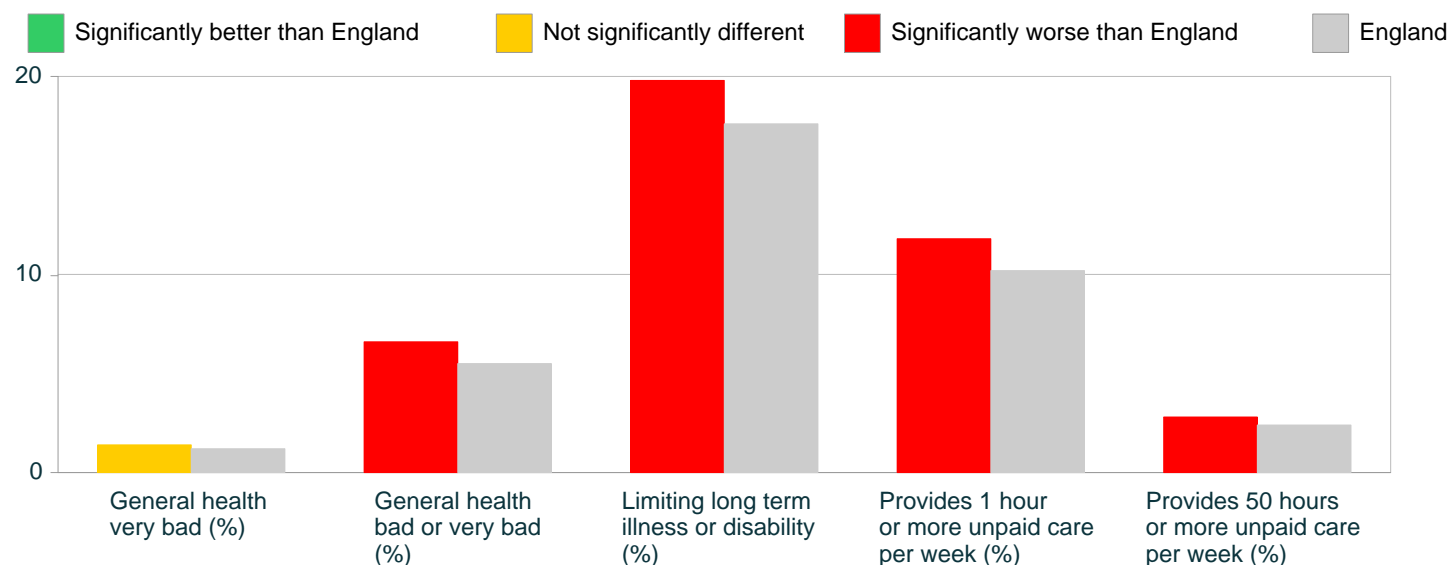

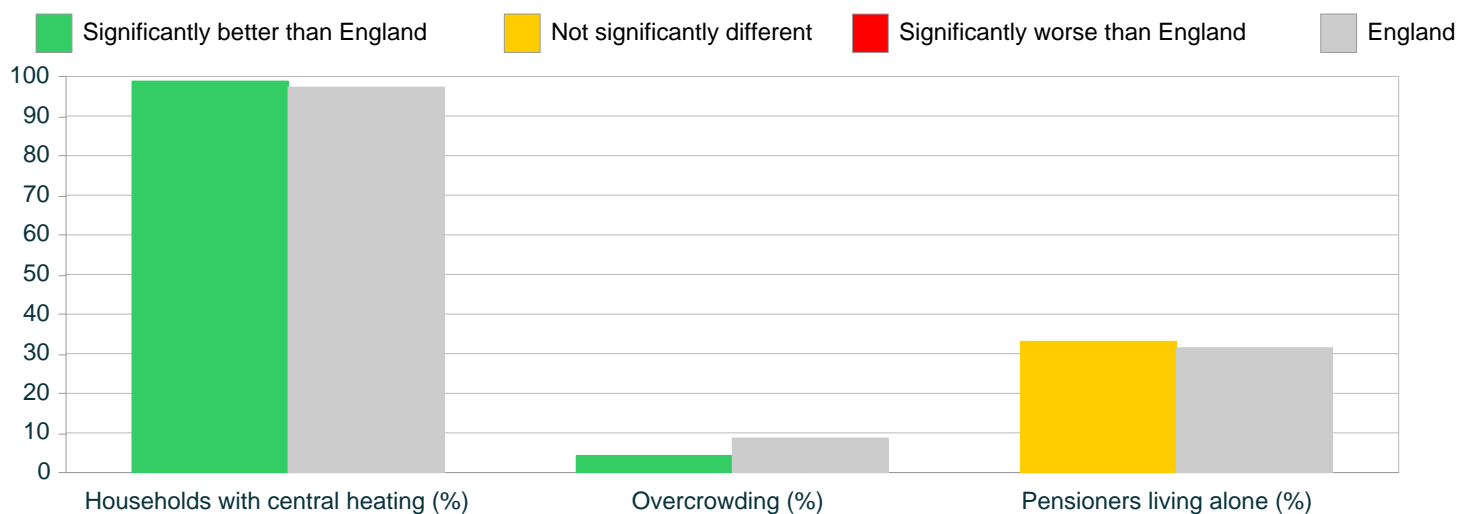

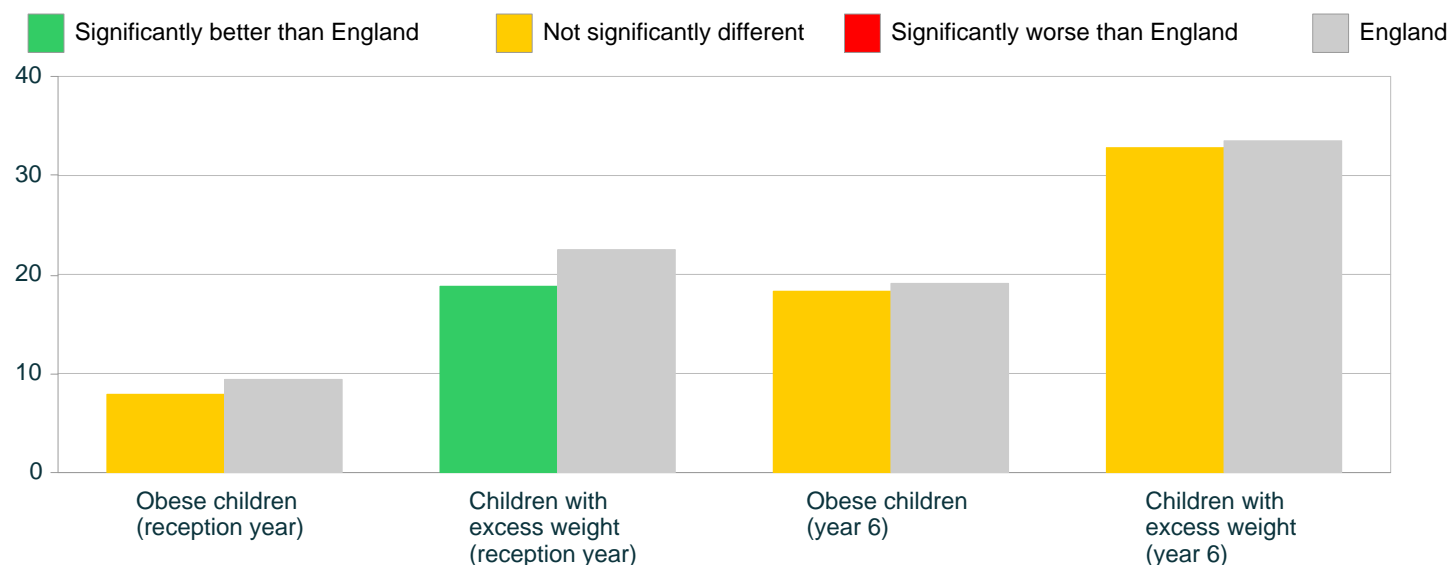

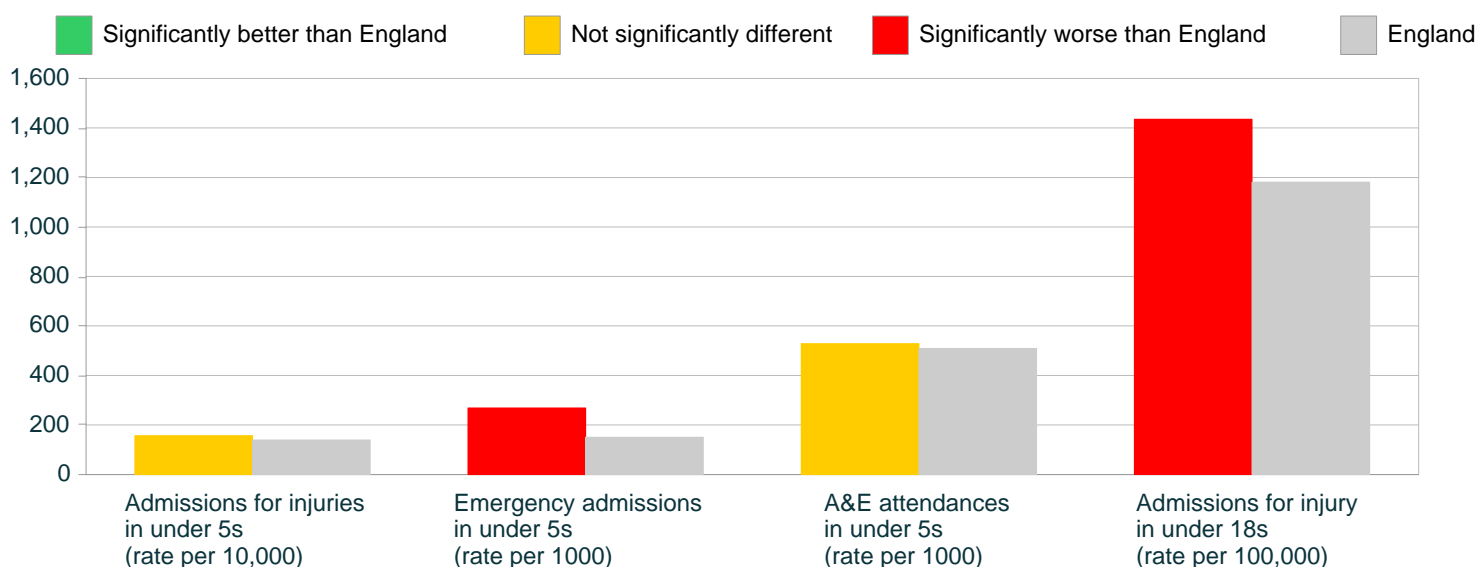

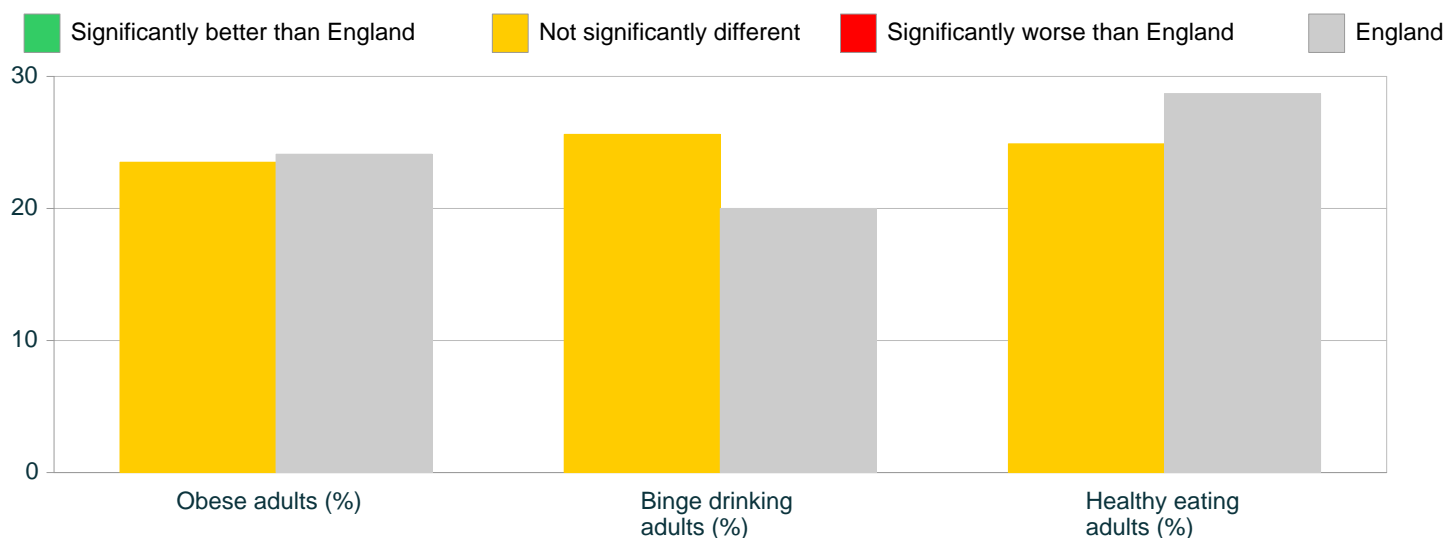

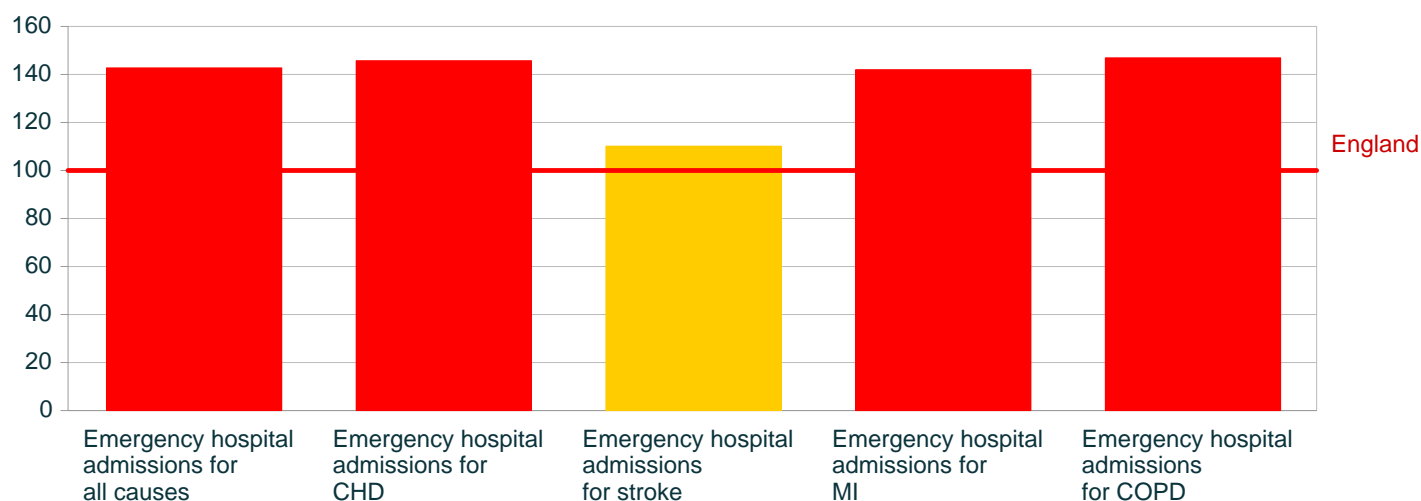

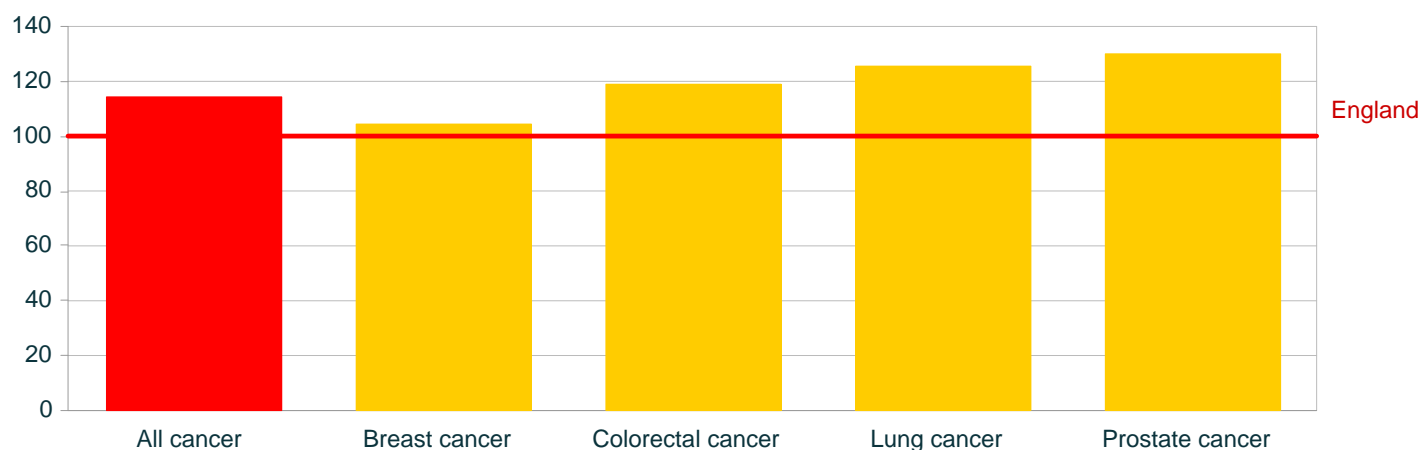

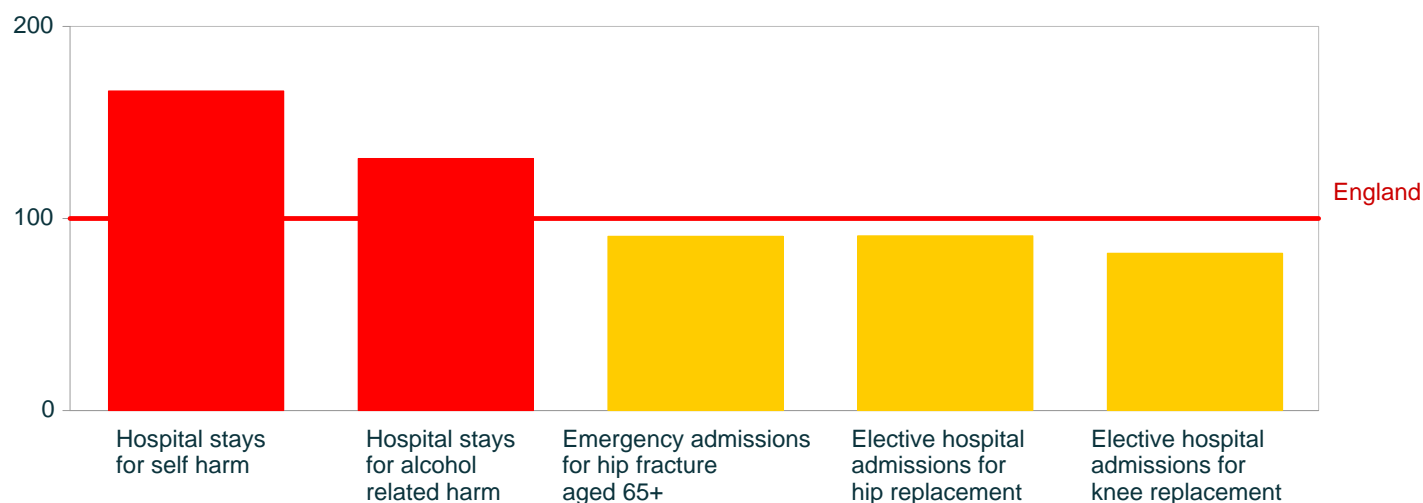

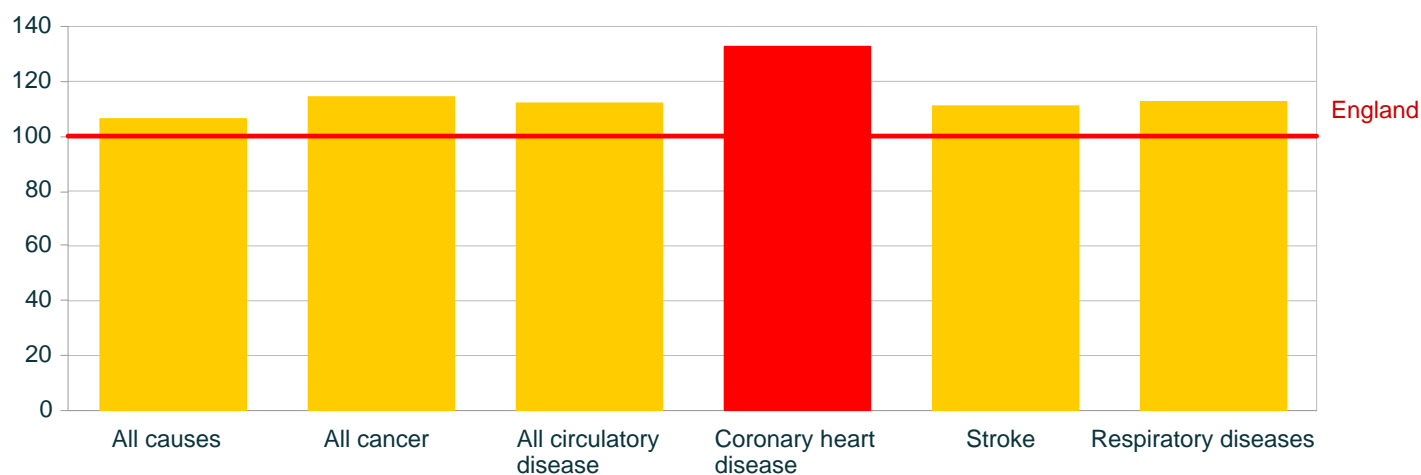

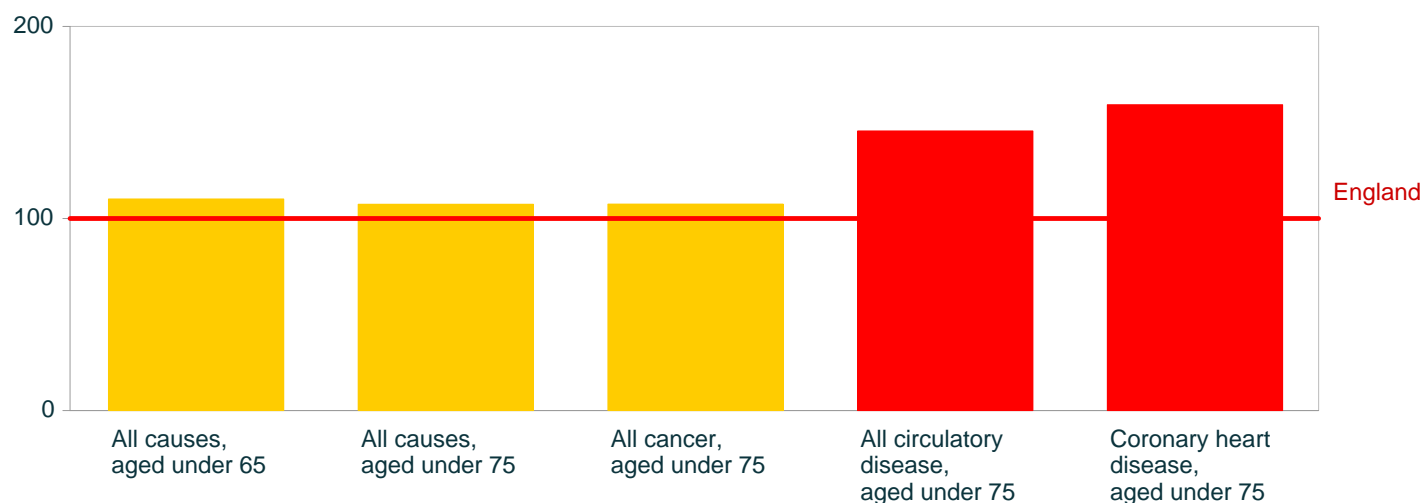

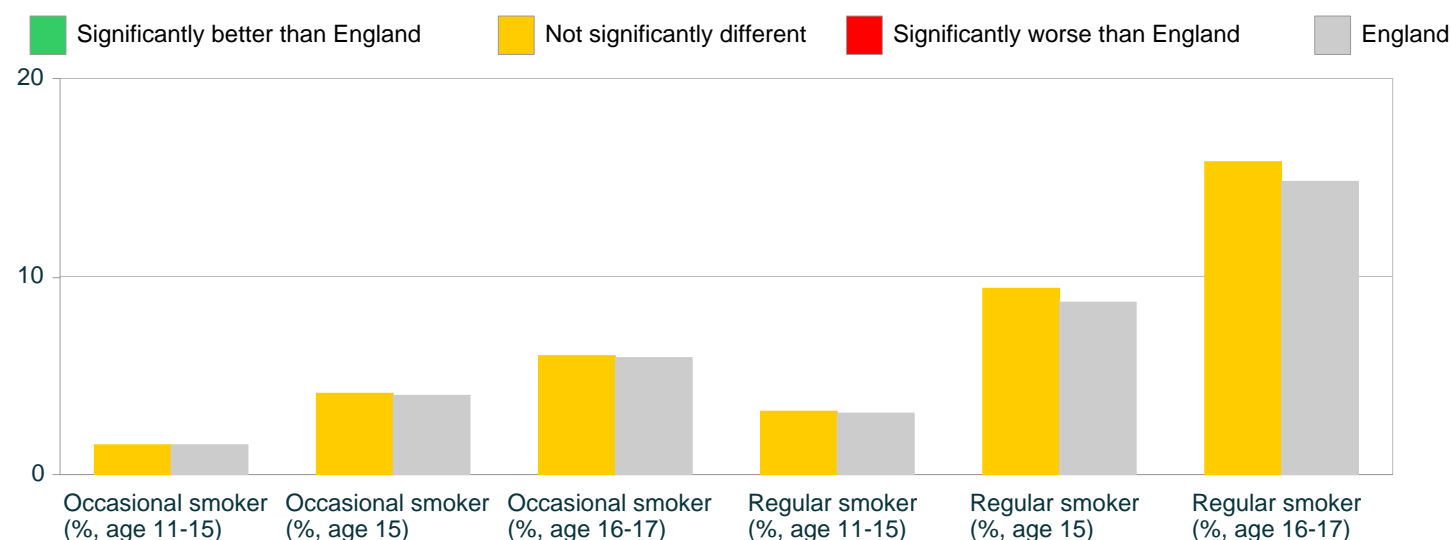

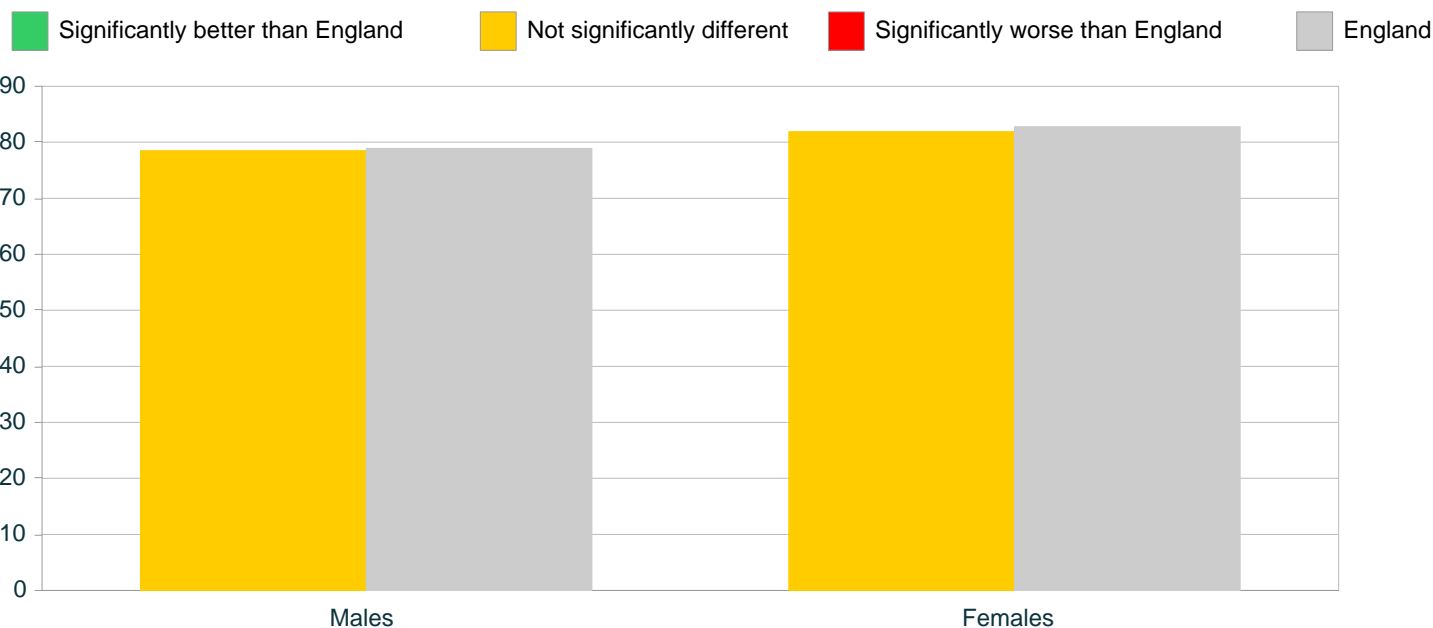
